

## SEASONAL FLU CAMPAIGN

We have had a good response so far to our 2009 flu campaign. However, we still have a lot of vaccine available and would encourage those at risk to make an appointment on 01778 393399. Letters reminding this group are being sent out as an additional reminder.

## H1N1 (Swine Flu)

We expect to take delivery of the first 500 doses in the next couple of weeks.

The clinical risk groups, in order of priority are:

- a) individuals aged 6 months and up to 65 years in the current seasonal flu vaccine clinical at-risk groups
- b) pregnant women
- c) household contacts of immuno-compromised individuals
- d) people aged 65 and over in the current seasonal flu vaccine clinical at-risk groups

Please be aware of the local press coverage and mailings to inform you when and where vaccination will take place.

## CHLAMYDIA

One in ten men and women under the age of 25 who are tested for chlamydia have been found to have the infection. The majority of people do not know that they have the infection. A simple test is available so ask your nurse or GP what you need to do. Every aspect is treated confidentially. You can ring to arrange an appointment on 01778 393399.
